Save the date! July 15 is the first day to sign up for any of SAWG's four premier workshops for the 2020-21 season. Enjoy the camaraderie of fellow artists from various backgrounds and ability levels while experiencing the mastery of a current watercolor great. Classes are small (approximately 20 students) and take place in a beautiful setting with an entire wall of natural light reflecting off a view of the Catalina Mountains. These are four opportunities to delve into artistic areas of growth and to evolve personal styles.

Spend two days with Don Andrews (Landscape Color and Composition), or four days with each of the others: Andy Evansen (Learn to Paint Stronger, Simpler Watercolors"), Mark Mehaffey (Experiment for Fun, Design for Success."), and Graham Berry (People at Work and Play"). Learn new tools, increase confidence, and take advantage of both group and personal instruction and critiques.

These workshops are well attended and fill fast, so set your calendar to remind you July 15 at noon to go online and sign up for one or more workshops. Details and descriptions of these workshop will be on the new website, which will launch by May 7th, and brochures will be available in the gallery when we are able to reopen.

EXPERIMENTAL SHOW

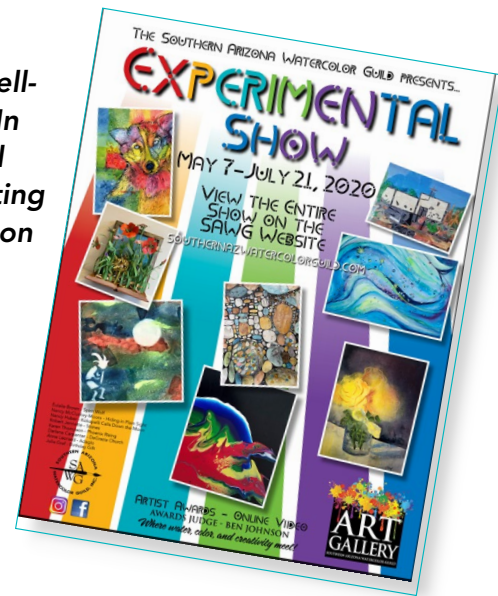
May 7 - July 21st

WESTERN FED 2020

... As We Continue to Wait, a Western Fed Update by Kay Sullivan

We eagerly await the Western Fed judging results, and then we await what will happen in Idaho. The team hosting the Western Fed exhibition have several “what-if” plans. As the virus progressed the organizers canceled all the activities at the Riverside hotel to save thousand of dollars in cancelation fees. They hope that the State Museum where the show is to hang will remain open. *Here are their words:*

“We are forging ahead with the WFWS-45 Exhibition. We have 3 options which time will tell which door we get to open:

1. *Health conditions rally and the Gala, Awards, public reception and Exhibition proceed as planned June 5-July 26 at the museum.*
2. *Exhibition is framed and hangs for only one month - July. We host a smaller public reception at the museum.*
3. *The museum does not reopen in time and we have an online Exhibition with video Including Quiller comments.*

We would hope each society will post this on their websites.”

We have seven members who have art in the Idaho Western Fed show. Let’s hope they win some of the \$10,000 in prize money!

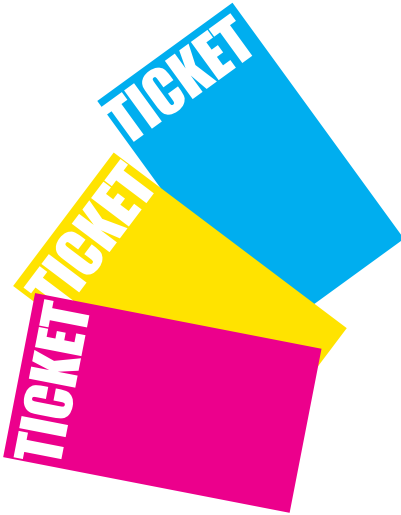
