WFWS 43 FULL REVIEW

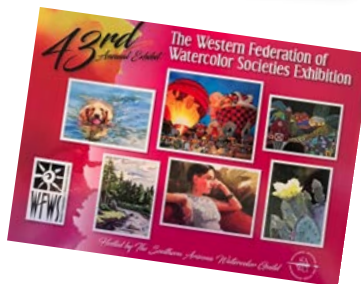

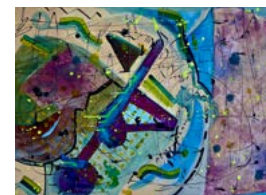

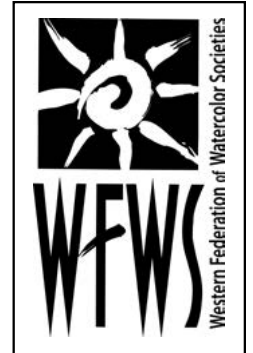
COLOR My World

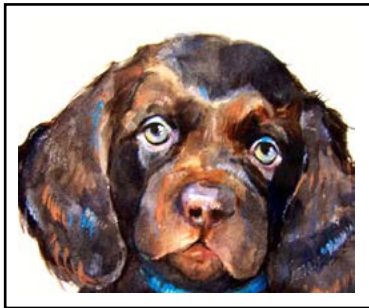
Workshops 2018-2019

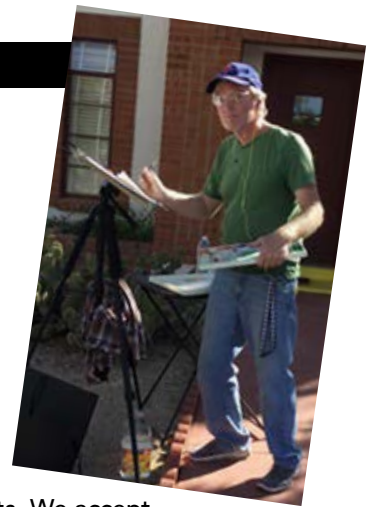
PLEIN AIR NEWS

SAWG will run ads on KUAZ NPR Radio FM, 89.1, AM 1550, October and November 2018. Ads will run on KXCI 91.3 FM in December '18 - January, 2019. Prime time, 5:30am – 7:00pm, opening week of shows. A free listing with photo/graphic will also be on the radio stations' online calendar.

Free ads with photo/graphic are placed monthly in Zocalo, Tucson Weekly, and Arizona Daily Star Newspaper's Caliente. All have on-line calendars. SAWG also purchases a listing in the Desert Leaf calendar each month. We will purchase a banner ad to run online in TucsonLocalMedia.com weekly newsletter for several months (NW Explorer, Foothills News and Saddlebrook areas). Many area newspapers will take articles/stories written by residents. Write a testimonial about your membership in SAWG and we will review, edit and submit it for publication (Green Valley).

Show Rack Cards need to be delivered regularly to public venues. Please volunteer to take an area of your neighborhood by zip code and deliver our cards. A map of geographic quadrants is available for members to select/sign up. Cards should be delivered to Resorts, Motels, Community Club Houses, Libraries, YMCA/YWCA, etc. Please explain to the venue, who we are and what the cards represent.

Outreach: SAWG answered a "Call to Artists" from an MDA support group. In October 2018, two member artists will create art with the 6-12 members for one afternoon.
